Bear River Massacre Recap



IWF Members, Sarah Michael, Nina Jonas, Susan Passovoy, and Janet Gallimore joined Darren Barry, the Chairman, of the Northwest Band of the Shoshone Tribe in honoring the 300 men, women and children that were massacred on January 29, 1863, in one of the largest attacks and murders of any tribe west of the Mississippi. Also, attending the ceremony was newly elected Idaho Governor Brad Little. This was the first time an Idaho Governor attended this important historical event.





State Historical Society Director Janet Gallimore organized a special evening meeting with the Chairman and attendance at this special event for IWF Members. We all felt that Chairman Darren Barry's accounting of his efforts to share the story of the Northwest Band of Shoshone Tribe at the Massacre site outside of Preston, Idaho, was one of the most moving and poignant ones we have heard. Thank you, Janet for organizing this amazing event for IWF Members.
