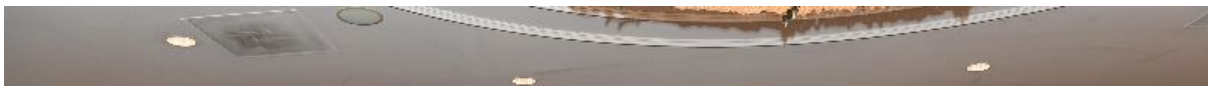
## LeeAnne Linderman

### Appointed to U.S. Department of Defense Advisory Committee



IWF Idaho Member, LeeAnne Linderman was sworn at the US Department of Defense to the Defense Advisory Committee on Women in the Services (DACOWITS). DACOWITS provides the Secretary of Defense with advice and recommendations on matters and policies relating to the recruitment, retention, employment, integration, well-being and treatment of women in the armed forces. When asked why she applied, LeeAnne stated that it stemmed from learning about issue of sexual trauma and the prevalence of homelessness for women veterans. For three years, she worked to provide housing and other needs for women veterans in Salt Lake City. With appointment to DACOWITS, LeeAnne plans to take her passion for women veterans "to the next level"--impacting military servicewomen and veterans across the country, not just in one state."
