Marcia Franklin's Behind the Scenes IPTV July 11 Tour Was a




On July 11, Marcia Franklin, a producer and host with Idaho Public Television, gave IWF members a tour of the station. Franklin, who has worked at IdahoPTV since 1990, explained the production process, including taking the group through the two studios in the building, the Master Control area and the tape library. A fun sidelight of the tour was seeing the area of the library that holds nearly 150 tapes from the documentary produced by Franklin on IWF member Barbara Morgan and her flight into space in 2007. General Manager Ron Pisaneschi explained the history of the station and its funding, more than half of which comes from private donations. The group also watched a clip of Franklin's newest documentary for "Idaho Experience," the station's history series. The program, "Out of the Shadows," looks at the lives and work of two women who photographed Native Americans in Idaho at the turn of the 20th century, Benedicte Wrensted and Jane Gay. It aired on Thursday, July 25 on Idaho Public Television at 8:30 p.m. Franklin's most recent documentary, "We Sagebrush Folks: Annie Pike Greenwood's Idaho," won a 2019 regional Emmy award in the historical category. It was one of two Emmys garnered this year by programs on which Franklin has worked.
